

Absconding Protocol

Missing (from the school premises)

Our procedures are designed to ensure that a missing young person is found and returned to effective supervision as soon as possible. If a young person goes missing, the following protocol will be activated:

- 1. The member of staff who had the last 'eyes on' the young person is to immediately inform the **DSL** and the **Head Teacher who will then inform admin** for register purposes
- 2. The member of staff will attempt to locate them.
- 3. If the child is located the member of staff will follow at a **safe distance** keeping them in sight but not chasing.
- 4. If the young person is deemed highly vulnerable, there are concerns around time of day, weather conditions or situation or staff have lost sight of for a prolonged period or cannot be located then the **DSL is to be updated**.
- 5. The member of staff will then contact the **police and parent/carer in conjunction with the DSL.**
- 6. The member of staff in conjunction with the DSL will **record a safeguarding log**.
- 7. If the young person then returns to School the **DSL** and **admin** must be notified immediately.
- 8. The member of staff in conjunction with the DSL will re contact the **Police and parent/carer before updating the safeguarding log**.
